Health Science and Human Anatomy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This course consists of the study of the human body, both structurally and functionally with emphasis on the pathophysiology and transmission of disease. Medical terminology is an integral part of the course.
Health Science Foundations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This course is designed to provide the student with an in depth knowledge of the health care system and associated occupations. Emphasis is placed on communication and interpersonal skills, use of technology, ethics and development of critical thinking, and problem-solving skills. Students will also learn first aid skills and demonstrate the measurement of vital signs.
Dental Aide 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This course provides classroom theory and practical application in tasks related to dental office asepsis and sterilization and disinfection procedures in the dental environment. It is designed to prepare completers for employment as dental aides specializing as dental sterilization techniques. It also provides an introduction to dentistry and dental assisting.
Practical Internship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This course is designed for students to gain practical hands-on knowledge of the field from accredited and experienced practices in the area. Students may shadow professionals throughout the course.
