## Graduation Requirements

- 24 Total credits
- 2.o Cumulative Unweighted Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Take the Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, U.S. History EOC and the results constitute $30 \%$ of the final course grade.
- Pass the Algebra I EOC or a comparative score on the PSAT Math; SAT Math; and ACT Math.
- Pass the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FSA Reading) or Obtain SAT/ACT Concordant Score
- Take and Pass an Online Course
- Complete a Community Service Project

## State Requirements for Graduation

- English
- Mathematics (Must have Algebra I, Geometry)
- Science (Must have Biology and 2 other courses, one having lab)

- Social Studies (W. History, US History, Gov’t/Econ.) 3
- Fine Art (Any Visual or Performing art) 1
- Physical Education (Pers. Fitness and $1 / 2$ cr. PE elective) $\mathbf{1}$

## Minimum Required Grade Point Average (GPA)

## (Continued)

- Students who enroll and complete a course and have received a grade of "D" MAY repeat that same course with a $C$ or better in order to replace the grade previously earned.
- Students who enroll and complete a course and have received a grade of " $F$ " MUST repeat that same course with a " $C$ " or better in order to replace the grade previously earned.
- F's will be included in your GPA if they are not replaced ( $\mathrm{F}=0$ points).


## Examples of 5 pt. Rule:

If you earn 5 points in the $1^{\text {st }}$ semester and earn 5 points in the $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ semester, credit is awarded.

If you earn 0 points in the $1^{\text {st }}$ semester and earn 10 points in the second semester, credit is awarded.

If you earn 10 points in the $1^{\text {st }}$ semester and earn less than 5 points in the $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ semester, credit is not awarded.

## AVENUES TO YOUR DESTINATION

- Florida Virtual School (www.flvs.net)

A way to earn high school credits online. Challenging curriculum, flexible scheduling, one-to-one instruction for the focused and motivated student. Check out the website for course offerings. Parent and guidance counselor approval required.

- $7^{\text {th }}$ Period, Summer School, Virtual School These are ways to make up credit and forgive any F's you may have earned in the past. You must see your guidance counselor for a registration form.


## Required Testing

- Pass the Algebra I EOC or a comparative score on the PSAT Math; SAT Math and ACT Math.
- Pass the Florida Standards Assessment English Language Arts (FSA ELA) or Obtain SAT/ACT Concordant Score

- Take the Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, U.S. History EOC; Results constitute $30 \%$ of the final course grade.


## Virtual Class Requirement

- All students need to take a virtual class before graduation. This can be fulfilled through Florida Virtual School.
- The course can be worth .5 credit or 1 credit.
- PLEASE NOTE: If you elect to take a 1 credit course you MUST complete the FULL course to fulfill the requirement.

- Community service hours must be completed with a non-profit or governmental institution.
- Remember to complete your community service packet and attach all required documents. Don't forget the essay!

## Florida Bright Futures Scholarship

The required community service hours to be completed for the following awards are:
Florida Academic Scholars (FAS)
100 hours
Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS)
75 hours
Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (GSV)
30 hours

2 years of a Foreign Language is Required.
